MAIN CAST

JAXON TURNER - (M. 25-30) Protagonist. All American top ranked Independent League baseball pitcher. After an attack, and an onset of depression, he must find the emotional and physical strength to learn to pitch with his opposite arm to get back in the game. He is married to his high school sweetheart and is an only child. He is athletic, attractive, independent and speaks his mind. Fluent in sarcasm especially when his world is crumbling. He is closed off from everyone and self-protects.

GRACIE TURNER - (F. 25-30) Attractor. After being in the foster care system as a child, she has a compassionate heart to care for others in need. She is a registered nurse of average height and build. She has a quiet confidence, a sweet disposition and is a natural encourager. She loves children and animals. Girl next door. She is loyal, thoughtful and her husband's biggest fan. She is a pillar of strength and love.

MISS HAZEL - (F. 50+) Guardian. Newly widowed friendly Christian neighbor and mighty prayer warrior. She is full of wisdom and truth, balanced with a sense of humor. She has the gift of hospitality. A strong woman of faith, she is well loved and respected among the community, her friends and church. She is tactful but direct. She is a servant leader. She enjoys baking, gardening and time with her prayer group. She is intentional about loving God and loving others.

*15 Days on set

FRANKIE BELLANO - (M. 25-30) Antagonist. Athletic top ranked Independent League Baseball hitter. Jaxon's former best friend turned rival enemy after a falling out years earlier. He is guarded, suspicious, defensive, over-protective and a grudge holder. He is the caretaker of his younger teen sister since their parents passed away. He is sometimes explosive and unpredictable, although deep down his desire is to do the right things for the right reasons.

*6 Days on set

CLARK TURNER - (M. 45+) Catalyst. Estranged wealthy father of Jaxon. After learning he has terminal cancer, he reaches out to his son to restore their relationship. He takes a series of actions to give his son back his dream and a better life. Once a strong business leader, now weak and bedridden, he is desperate to right some wrongs and leave the world without regrets. He is understanding, patient and wise. He is an honorable man and a class act.

*4 Days on set

SERGEANT PIPER - (M. 50+) Trickster. Single retired military drill sergeant commissioned to lead the training team and program with militant discipline, tough love and unconventional tactics. He is highly motivated and challenges the will and goals of others. He is no-nonsense and impatient. He is loud, forward, intolerant and set in his ways. He is sharp-witted and often heavy

handed. Expectant of quick results, he is often frustrated with the training progress and things that distract from or delay the goal.

*10 Days on set

JAY RITTER - (M. 40+) Sidekick. Famous retired Major league pitcher. Essential part of the training team. He is hard working, understanding and the voice of reason. He is steady, supportive, focused on the mission, confident, logical, never losing his cool. He has a muscular build and is greatly admired. He is a true team player who believes in Jaxon and sincerely wants him to succeed. He is a peacemaker.

ROBBIE GALUBSKI - (M. 25+) Comic Relief. Adorned with black rimmed glasses and a bow tie, he is the over-analytical statistical genius of the training team. He carries an iPad crammed with statistics and notes. Numbers are his life. He is always evaluating numerical possibilities and outcomes. He is very expressive, highly intelligent, socially awkward and often clumsy. Unintentionally comical. He is a bio-mechanical analyst.

ANNA (F. 40+) Estranged mother of Jaxon and Former drug addict. After years of drug abuse, she is finally living clean. She is out to make up for her mistakes and taking responsibility for them. She looks as if she has had some rough experiences, but her eyes remain kind.

MISS PAT (F. 50+) Owner of a successful local diner where regulars come to eat. She loves the Lord and is a hard working business woman. She respects all people. She is passionate and straight forward. She is an active member of the prayer team.

MISS HELEN (F. 50+) Secretary of the church, Miss Helen tries to appear well-put together. She is classy and stands tall no matter what. She comes from a wealthy family and wears her pearls to all events big or small.

*7 Days on set

MISS MARY (F. 50+) Works as a cook at Miss Pat's diner. She loves food. She loves to cook it and eat it. She is funny and is often found eating a pastry. She keeps the laughter among the group of four best friends.

*7 Days on set

PASTOR DAVE (M. 60+) The Pastor of the local dwindling church. He has great compassion for the people of the town and abroad. He is a God-fearing man who begins to waiver in his faith in times of trouble. He is very respected and appreciated.

*3 Days on set

ZOE (F. 18) The younger sister of Frankie Bellano, she works at Miss Pat's Diner as a waitress. She has long hair and is kind and forgiving. She is her brother's biggest fan and never misses a game.

HANK (M. 25-30) Relief pitcher for Jaxon in an independent league. He is conceited and extremely competitive. He gives Jaxon a lot of grief both on and off the field.
